

## Terms and Conditions

In completing this application, you will provide us with information about yourself. This may include items such as your name, gender, address, phone number, email address, bow style, Archery GB number and information about any disabilities or special requirement that you have. It might be necessary to share some of these items with others involved in the participation and management of the event. For example, your name will appear in the target lists and results will be shared with national and regional governing bodies and published on our club website. You may also appear in photographs taken of the event.

Only members of Archery GB, World Archery or a member of a recognised archery society having valid public liability insurance cover applicable to an Archery GB event are permitted to shoot at this tournament.

Participants may be approached to give a sample for drug testing and are required to comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Anyone wishing to take photographs must register with the desk at the beginning of each day.

Archery GB (or WA, or other recognised body) Membership cards must be presented at registration. If you are a new member and have not yet received your membership card then a receipt from your club's treasurer will suffice.

Only entries on the official entry form (or photocopies / scanned copies) will be accepted and these will be treated strictly in order of receipt.

Competitors must comply with Archery GB dress regulations.

## Tournament and Venue Information

**Venue:** Knutsford Sports Club, Mereheath Lane, Knutsford, Cheshire WA16 6SZ.

**Date:** Sunday, 10<sup>th</sup> May 2020

The tournament will be run in accordance with WA rules and bye laws which are current at the time.

**Rounds:** **WA 70m round**  
Recurve and longbow archers will shoot 6 dozen arrows per session at 70m on 122 cm faces.

**Barebow WA 50m round**  
Barebow archers will shoot 6 dozen arrows per session at 50m on 122 cm faces.

**Compound WA 50m round**  
Compound archers will shoot 6 dozen arrows per session at 50m on individual 80 cm six ring faces.

**Timings:** **Morning**  
Equipment checks will start at 9:00 am and assembly will take place at 9:30 am. This will be followed by two ends of practice and the competition will begin immediately afterwards.

**Afternoon**  
The afternoon session will begin after the lunch break. For those participating in the afternoon session only, two ends of practice will be allowed directly before shooting commences.

**Refreshments:** Barm cakes with a selection of bacon, sausage, spam and egg will be available from first thing in the morning. Burgers and soup will be added to the menu at lunchtime, and a wide range of cakes will be available throughout the afternoon. Tea, coffee, hot chocolate and a selection of cold drinks and confectionary will be served all day.

**Safety:** As the ground is used throughout the summer as a cricket field as well as an archery range, it is imperative that the tournament organizer is made aware of any lost arrows along with a rough indication of where the arrow is likely to be found. Please see a member of the field party for help finding it.

**Bosses:** All archers will shoot on ProBoss Foam Bosses

**Parking:** Main parking will be available across the road from the club at the Bowling Club. Please fill up there first. A member of the field party will be on site to direct you. If you have a mobility problem which will make it difficult for you to get to the range from the car park across the road, please let us know when you submit the entry form.

**Awards will be presented for first, second and third place in each bow style (recurve, compound, longbow, barebow):**
